Thank you for your interest in our Career Scholarship Program. We are proud to have the opportunity to further aviation education. Enclosed is an Application for the scholarships to be awarded in 2012, as well as the Letter of Recommendation Form.

Please fill out the Application completely and accurately. Remember that all we will know about you is what you tell us in your application. The completed application must be postmarked by May 1, 2012, in order for you to be eligible.

Please give the Letter of Recommendation Form to someone other than a relative who knows you well enough to give us an impression of you. The person filling out the form should return it directly to us at the address below postmarked no later than May 1, 2012. It is your responsibility to ensure that the form is mailed in time.

If you are applying for an academic degree, we require an official transcript or school record of your grades from the last school you attended. The school may mail this directly to us or you may include it with the application. In either case, it must be postmarked by May 1, 2012. Please request the copy of your transcript as soon as possible, as this can be a time-consuming process. Please note that the lack of a transcript is the number one reason applicants fail to make the finalist list.

Please feel free to make copies of this Application and cover letter for any other interested people. Remember that applicants must be at least 18 years of age, U. S. Citizens, and reside in the Greater Los Angeles Area. Members of the Ninety-Nines and their families are not eligible.

The interviews of all scholarship finalists will be held at Van Nuys Airport in mid-May. The winners of the \$3,000 scholarships will be invited to attend our Awards Banquet in June, where they will be recognized.
