GROUND-BASED ACTIVITIES

- Attendance at FAA Safety Seminars
- Re-currency training – including research and simulator training
- Physiological training – one example is the high-altitude chamber
- Aviation judge training & judging – i.e. NIFA, WPFC, etc.
- Aircraft maintenance training – ie, Cessna Powerplant Course
- Any ground school course – i.e., AOPA or CAP training course (mountain flying, floatplane, etc.)
- Participating in or setting up a fly-in
- Member of an aviation Board

FLIGHT ACTIVITIES

- Wings certification – any level
- Re-currency training – BFR, APT, IPC (including competency checks)
- Any new rating
- Check out in new aircraft type (high-performance, tailwheel, glider, ultralight, balloons, floatplane, etc.)
- Check rides with organizations such as Angel Flight, Los Medicos, Flying Samaritans, Civil Air Patrol, Sheriffs Patrol, etc.
- First parachute jump
- Fly-in – pilot or passenger
